THE NATIONAL COUNCIL ON ADOPTION. THERE WERE 17.3 INFANT ADOPTIONS FOR EVERY 1.000 ABORTIONS. AMONG NON-MARITAL BIRTHS, THERE WERE 11.4 INFANT ADOPTIONS FOR EVERY 1,000 ABORTIONS, MEANING ONLY 1 PERCENT OF UNMARRIED MOTHERS CHOSE ADOPTION IN 2014.




AWAITING ADOPTION. NEARLY HALF (59.430) WERE ADOPTED.



We need federal legislation that makes both abortion and adoption reporting mandatory so we have an accurate picture of what is happening to the most vulnerable among us: our children.
