

Age is a factor. The CDC reported\* in 2005 that maternal mortality was *5 times higher* for women over 35 years old [38 per 100,000 live births] than for women 20 and younger [7.4 per 100,000 live births]. In 1987, the U.S. MMR rate was 7.2. It has more than *doubled* since then despite the fact that Planned Parenthood's taxpayer funding increased *5.7x* from \$97 million to \$553.7 million in 2014. \*http://web.archive.org/web/20130308095755/http://mchb.hrsa.gov/whusa08/hstat/mh/pages/237mm.html

## FALSE

Adjusted maternal mortality rates for Texas show only a modest increase from 2000 to 2010, from a rate of 17.7 in 2000 to 18.6 in 2010. However, after 2010, the reported maternal mortality rate for Texas doubled within a 2-year period to levels not seen in other U.S. states.

## TRUE

- From 2000 to 2010 the MMR more than doubled from 10.5 to 24.6. That's not a modest increase.
- MMR did not double after 2010. Even if you were to take the rate in 2010 (24.6) and compare it to 2013 (39.5), that's an increase of 61%.
- Causes of maternal deaths in Texas were found to be: Cardiac events (20.6%), Drug overdose (11.6%), Hypertension/eclampsia (11.1%), Hemorrhage (9%), Sepsis (9%), Homicide (7.4%), and Suicide (5.3%) Data Source: http://bit.ly/TX-DSHS-Factors
